New Categories: ~90 new categories added to Places flat file and Places API

With over 1200 category labels available, Foursquare's proprietary category taxonomy offers customers precise ways to filter and analyze the data.

In June, 2023, we added an additional 90 new categories to the taxonomy to allow our customers to use and analyze the data in the ways that makes sense for their business.

Heatmap Chart




Labels: Text Outline

The Data SDK now offers support for Data Connectors. List available data connectors, execute queries, and create datasets from queries via a new set of Data SDK endpoints.

Functionality Service Accounts (Enterprise Only)

The ability to create a Service Account on behalf of your application in order to generate OAuth tokens. Service account level OAuth tokens are valid only for use with the Foursquare Movement Geofence API. This feature is only available for Enterprise accounts.


